

## **Detail information for availing treatment facility at LGBRIMH, Tezpur (Assam)**

Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health (LGBRIMH), Tezpur (Assam) is a premier Mental Health Institute in Northeast India. The Institution was established in the year 1876 and is recognized as one of the oldest centers providing quality mental health care and treatment. The Institute is mandated to be a tertiary care institute of Mental Health & Neurosciences and it is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India.

**OPD Services:** The OPD services are available Six days a week from Monday to Saturday. OPD remains closed on Sundays and on the three National Holidays (Independence Day, Republic Day and Gandhi Jayanti).

**Patient registration:** Registration is mandatory on every visit for any consultation at the OPD.

**OPD Timing:** 9.00 AM to 2.00 PM

**Mode of Registration-**

1. In- person registration: There are separate registration desks for New and Old Registration that is, for patients visiting for the first time and patient coming on subsequent visits, respectively. Separate registration counters available for specially abled, senior citizen, pregnant woman etc.

#### **OPD for Superspeciality Departments:**

1. Department of Addiction Medicine (Gate No 7): OPD Days- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.
2. Child & Adolescent Psychiatry(Gate No 3): OPD Days- Monday to Saturday
3. Geriatric Mental Health(Gate No 1): OPD Days- Monday to Saturday

**Treatment:** In the outpatient, the patient will be assessed by a team consisting of Psychiatrists, Psychologists, Psychiatric Social Workers and Psychiatric Nursing and treatment will be provided accordingly.

**Other facilities in OPD:** OPD has a Pharmacy, dispensing a wide range of Psychotropic medicines free of cost to the patients availing treatment from the Institute. There is also a **JAN Aushadhi Kendra** near Gate No 1 where Psychotropic medicine and General medicine is provided at subsidized rate. Beside these, there is a laboratory sample collection room available in the OPD (Room No 33) for laboratory investigations of the patients attending the OPD free of cost.

**Indoor Admission Procedure:** The Mental Health Care Act, 2017 is strictly followed during the admission procedure. In the OPD, psychiatrist conducts a detailed evaluation of patient. Based on clinical findings, the psychiatrist will determine whether in-patient admission is required and admitted accordingly as per provisions of The Mental Health Care Act, 2017. **There is no bed charge.** The formalities of admission procedure are carried out in designated room (Room No 29) by designated persons after the advice of admission by Psychiatrist.

**Visitors Policy for inpatients:** Two passes will be issued for each admission

1. Attendant pass (Pink) - One Attendant will be allowed for each patient
2. Visitor Pass (Yellow)- One visitor allowed at a time during visiting hours
3. One attendant has to stay with the patient during the patient's indoor stay period
4. Visiting hours: 11 am to 1 pm and 4pm to 6 pm

**Indoor Services:** The total bed strength of the hospital is 336 beds distributed among various departments of the Institute. The indoor treatment team consists of Psychiatrists, Psychologists, Psychiatric Social Workers and Psychiatric Nursing including ward sisters and staff nurses. The Indoor provides regular patient care services including evaluation and treatment, hygienic and nutritious diet, laundered clothes, recreation facilities and other basic amenities.

**Superspeciality Services:** There are separate wards for Superspeciality Departments as follows:

1. Department of Addiction Medicine(24 bedded)
2. Child & Adolescent Psychiatry(24 bedded)
3. Geriatric Mental Health(24 bedded)
